

AUGUST 30, 2018

The Greene City Council met in special session on Thursday, August 30, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. in the Greene Community Center with Mayor James O'Brien presiding. Council members present were Marnie Schmidt, Al Zweck and Denise Shreve. Marilyn Folkers and Ben Backer were absent. Rustin Lingbeek was also present.

Motion by Zweck/Schmidt to approve the agenda. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Motion by Schmidt/Shreve to approve the August 13<sup>th</sup> minutes. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Mayor O'Brien stated that this was the time and place for a public hearing to review and application for a State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan and to make available environmental information for the City's lagoon project. Rustin Lingbeek from SEH spoke briefly with the Council regarding the progress of the project. There are no significant environmental impacts involved with this project. There were no other oral or written comments and the hearing was closed.

Shreve introduced Resolution 2018-27 a resolution approving the 2017-2018 Street Finance Report. Seconded by Schmidt. Roll was called and the vote was AYES: Zweck, Schmidt and Shreve. NAYS: None. ABSENT: Folkers and Backer. MC

Zweck introduced Resolution 2018-28, a resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign a contract with the Iowa Department of Transportation regarding funding agreement for the West South Street Overflow bridge project. Seconded by Schmidt. Roll was called and the vote was AYES: Zweck, Schmidt and Shreve. NAYS: None. ABSENT: Folkers and Backer. MC

WHEREUPON the Mayor declared Resolutions 2018-27 and 2018-28 duly adopted. (Mayor's signature affixed and made a permanent part of these minutes.)

Motion by Schmidt/Shreve to contact the City Attorney and proceed with steps necessary to move forward with flood buy-out for property at 216 South First Street. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Clerk's request to purchase two new computers for City Hall was tabled until the September meeting when more information will be available.

Motion by Zweck/Schmidt to hire Summit Companies to install fire sprinklers in the Community Center's storage room addition at a cost of \$3000. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Motion by Shreve/Zweck to approve a Class C Liquor License with Sunday Sales for TJ's Bar and Grill. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Nuisance abatements were briefly discussed.

Motion by Schmidt/Shreve to adjourn at 6:17.
